Step I (General)

Navigate to the main Archive page (<http://oldcolony.us/archives/main.htm>). Each set of years is broken down into many categories. Let’s start off with “School News 2010-2011” page.

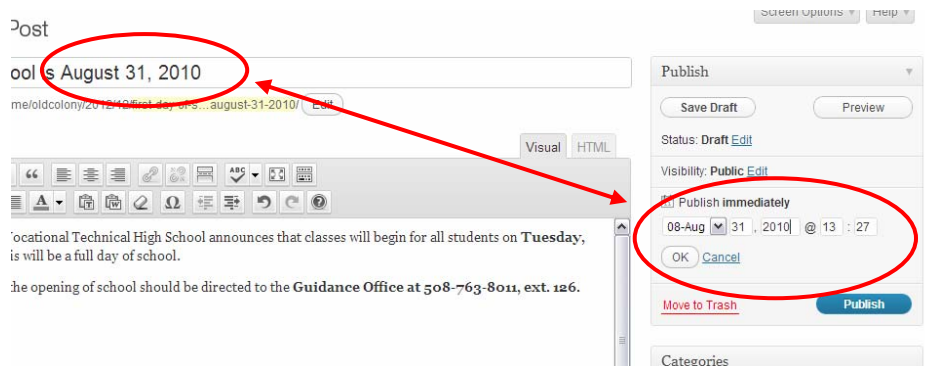

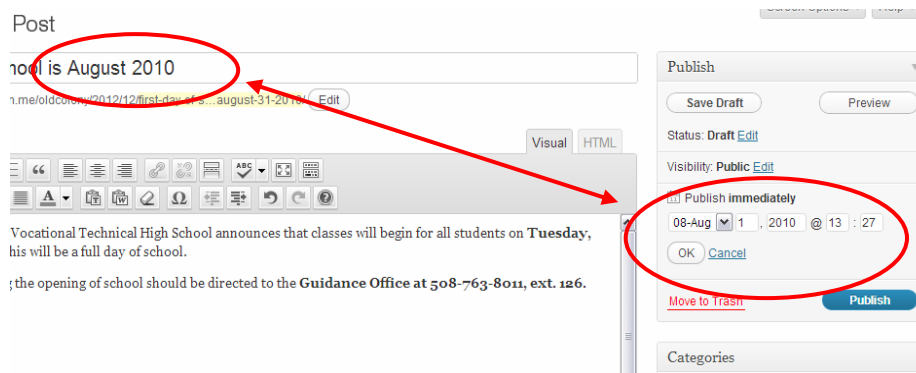
Old Colony Regional Vocational Technical High School announces that classes will begin for all students on Tuesday, August 31, 2010. This will be a full day of school.

Inquiries concerning the opening of school should be directed to the Guidance Office at 508-763-8011, ext. 126.

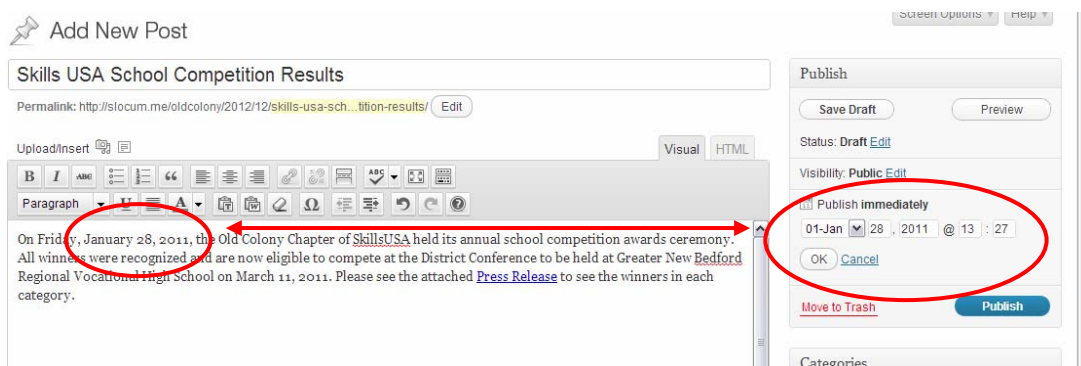
If the post has an exact date (e.g. August, 31, 2010): change the post date to match the month, day, and year. You can ignore the hour and minute.



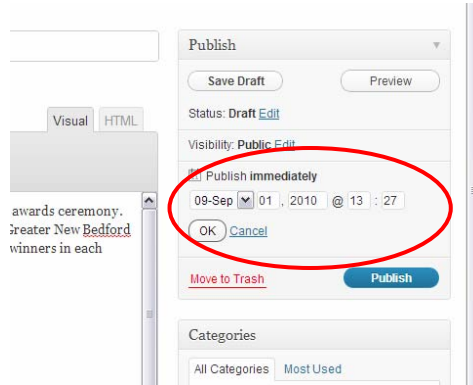
If the post has a partial date (e.g. August, 2010): change the post date to match the month and year. The day should always be set to 1 (first of the month) in this case. You can ignore the hour and minute.



If the date is in the post content (e.g. On Friday, January 28, 2011, the Old Colony): change the post date to match the month, day and year. You can ignore the hour and minute.

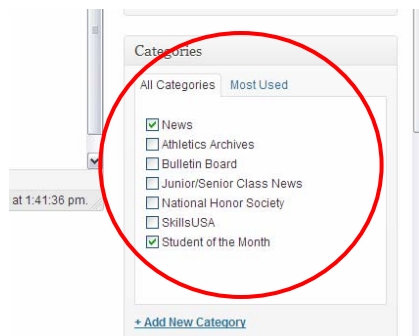


If the date is no where to be found: change the post date to 09-Sep, 01, %YEAR% (where year is the first year of the current archive). Here's an example: if you were transferring archives from 2010-2011, and there was no date, you should set the post date to 09-Sep, 01, 2010.



Categories: All posts will have to be categorized correctly. Please check off all categories that apply. Here's an example: if you were transferring archives from the Student of the Month section from 2010-2011, you would check off "Student of the Month"

Please Note: The "News" category is the default category and will automatically be selected. Please leave this category selected.
