

It is hard to believe that in 1972 when Mr. Oliveira first conceived his plans of building a regional school in the small town of Rochester that it would grow and prosper to the success it has over 20 years later.

In 1975, Mr. Oliveira, the school's original superintendent, opened the doors to four eager towns: Acushnet, Carver, Rochester and Mattapoisett, only excepting a freshman, a sophomore and a small junior class. Over the years, the participation from the surrounding towns has increased, as two new towns, Lakeville and Freetown, have entered our vocational system.

In 1981, the number of trades that were offered at our school decreased from 14 to 12, losing Consumer Homemaking, Child Care, and Business Technology, and adding Health Services. That still left us with a great variety of shops to choose from.

In 1991 we began working in our chosen trade, starting from scratch, having little, if any, knowledge of it. We entered this school full of anticipation and without many friends and as the years went by, we became closer to each other, gaining new friends and keeping the old. There are memorable times that we have shared and we will always cherish them. It always seems to be, that every time we lost a friend, there was a new one waiting for our companionship. We'll always have our memories, whether they were during happy times or sad.

When we finally break out our yearbooks many years from now and read the following commencement speech by Kevin Marcondes, we hope it will bring back memories of new beginnings and carefree days gone by.

"Four years ago, my fellow students and I began a new chapter in our lives, a chapter called High School. We began this chapter much as one would begin any other chapter of a good book: with excitement, anxiety, and anticipation.

As time progressed and we read deeper and deeper into our own personal chapters, the excitement, anxiety, and anticipation left us. We made friends and enemies. We got to know each other, our teachers, and our school better. We watch our seniors graduate and began looking forward to the day when we, too, would graduate. The Junior Varsity team posted a 7 win 2 loss record.



















































Soccer




















Girls Basketball




















Baseball
