Colophon

Quittacus Log, volume twenty-one, was printed in Dallas, Texas, by Taylor Publishing Company. Our publishing representative was Conrad Schmidt. Taylor Publishing printed 140 books, each selling for \$75. The book includes 112 pages, covering events from fall 1997 through spring 1998 and also includes eight additional pages of Taylor's supplemental color current events section.

The typefaces include Times New Roman Bold for the headlines and Times New Roman Standard for the body copy. Varsity was used in the senior portrait section.

Our Maroon Frontier cover has a Cougar's paw die cut cover. The endsheet design uses gold foil on the front cover and rainbow maroon on the back.

The book was Smyth binded, long side. The pages were printed on 80% pound enamel paper in trim size 8 1/2 by 11. One four-color signature was used for the senior portrait section.

Taylor's Backdrops were used for the shops/seniors' towns (BD17BW), underclassmen (BD13BW), Homecoming and baby pictures (BD46BW), Excellence in Effort (BD21BW), clubs (BD14BW), senior profiles (BD08BW), proms (BD29BW), graduation (BD40BW) and ad (BD16BW) sections. Taylor's Pop Print screened at 10%, provides the background for copy in the sports section (PP920) and Spirit Week (PP910).

The staff produced the entire book using Microsoft Word '97 and Adobe Pagemaker 6.0 on IBM computers. The senior portraits were taken by various area photographers while Tom Pacheco Studios took the underclassmen portraits and most of the other school activities and sports pictures.
