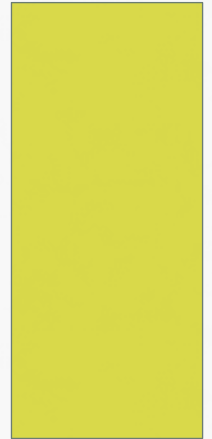

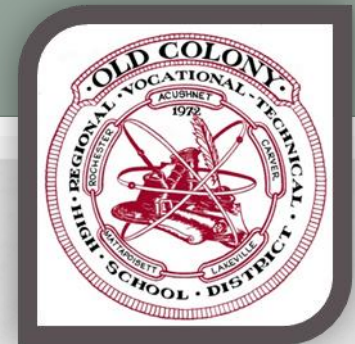

WHAT IS TITLE I?



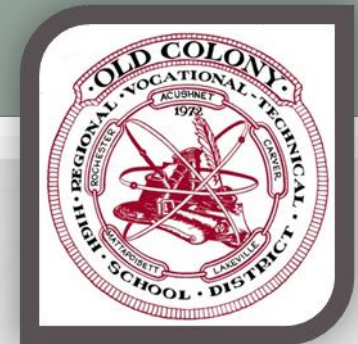
TITLE I INFORMATION

- Serves more than 18 million students nationwide
- Part of the Every Student Succeeds Act
 - Was initiated in 1965 as part of the War on Poverty
 - Last revised as the No Child Left Behind Act in 2001
- Not just for low income students
- Serves students Pre-K through 12th grade
- Single largest pre-college federal education program

TITLE I INFORMATION

- Title I students are found in almost every school district in the country
- Provides financial assistance to districts and schools to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards
- Two types of school based programs:
 - Schoolwide
 - Targeted Assistance

- Targeted Assistance Program
- Students are ranked by
 - MCAS test scores
 - Failed subject grades in high school
 - IEP, 504 and ELL
 - EPP program enrollment
 - Teacher recommendation
- Title I Fall Packet
- Chromebooks
- ASSISTments
- Supplemental programs to guide students to success on the MCAS test
 - Required to pass in order to receive a high school diploma in MA

MCAS TEST SCHEDULE

- **Gr. 9**

- Science Technology & Engineering
 - June 6 & 7, 2018
 - Must score at least Needs Improvement (≥ 220)

- **Gr. 10**

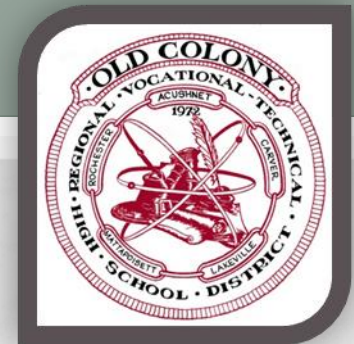
- English Language Arts
 - March 27, 28 & 29, 2018
 - Must score at least Proficient (≥ 240)
- Math
 - May 23 & 24, 2018
 - Must score at least Proficient (≥ 240)

• Proficient	240–258
• Needs Improvement	220–238
• Warning (grades 3–8)	200–218
• Failing (high school)

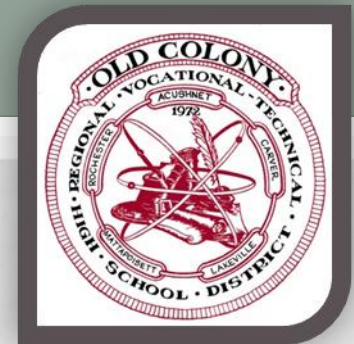
EDUCATIONAL PROFICIENCY PLAN

- **Only for students who have scored Needs Improvement on the English Language Arts and Math MCAS Test**
- Required by the State
- Old Colony School District EPP Plan:
 - Meet graduation requirements per student handbook
 - Comply with OC attendance policy
 - Successful completion of ELA and/or Math required course(s)
 - Participate in at least one support program w/ at least 90% attendance
 - Junior year is mandatory
 - Participate in the District's pre and post MCAS support course assessments to demonstrate measureable progress
 - Participate in all the MCAS EPP/Retest test opportunities

TITLE I PROGRAMS AT OC

- Teachers are licensed in the subject area
- No more than 12 students per teacher
- Copy of most recent MCAS Test (if available)
- Each student's item analysis
- Test taking strategies

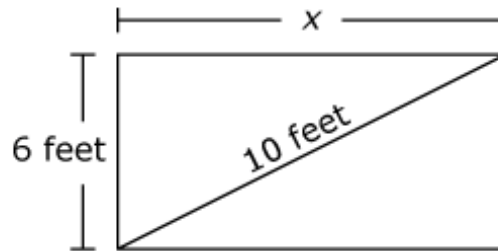


HOW TO GET INVOLVED

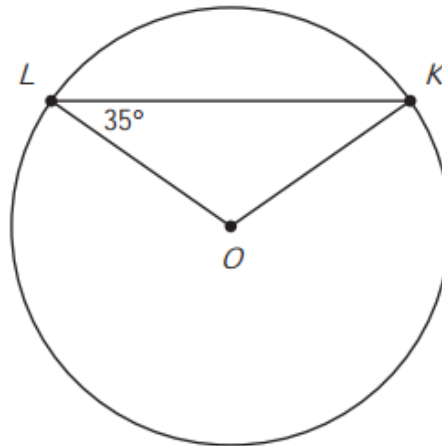

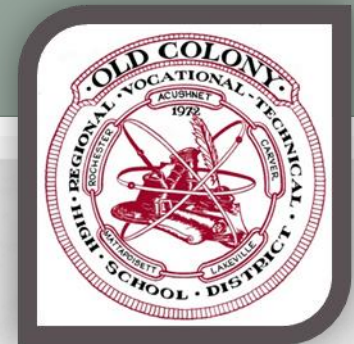
PREPARE FOR MCAS

- Communicate it's importance
 - Can stop students from receiving a high school diploma
 - Avoid having to join EPP/Remediation programs
- Remind them
 - Mark it on calendar at home
- Good nights sleep
 - Not just the day before
- Healthy breakfast and dinner before
- Encouragement
 - Especially for EPP and Remediation Programs
- Ease anxiety
 - Different for each child
