Dear Old Colony Community,

We hope this letter finds you healthy and in good spirits as the weather begins to change and we welcome the upcoming Thanksgiving Holiday. The past two years have presented us with our share of challenges and obstacles. We continue to process the plethora of information shared by the Department of Elementary of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state while working to maintain a supportive environment for students and staff. The following information is offered as an update with the most recent information available specific to the pandemic.

- A total of 14 positive cases have been reported to our Nurses' Office since the start of school in late August of 2021.
- Consistent with the authority provided by the Board of Education, and after consulting with medical experts and state officials, the Commissioner has extended the mask requirement through at least January 15, 2022. The Department will continue to work with medical experts and health officials to evaluate the mask requirement beyond January 15.
- Old Colony is currently offering the Test and Stay program to minimize interruption to learning loss. Only students who have received parental permission are permitted to participated in the Test and Stay program. Additional information is available through our Nurses' Office.
- The Town of Rochester will be offering vaccination clinics for those interested on the following dates:
