

Upper Cape Cod Regional Technical School, Tri-County Regional Vocational Technical School, Old Colony Regional Vocational Technical School and Tantasqua Regional Technical School will be revising the Culinary Arts VTEF under the Hospitality and Tourism Occupational Cluster through a grant funded through the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. The partnership is recruiting for members of a Team to revise and update the Culinary Arts VTEF and develop Program of Study grids. The following immediate positions are available:

- 1 experienced facilitator and partnership administrator, Chapter 74 certified in Culinary Arts, with a vocational technical supervisor-director background and experience in developing frameworks, program of study grids and crosswalks.
- 5 highly qualified Culinary Art teachers currently using the VTEF – Instructors must have a certification in the area they represent and have at least 3 years teaching in a vocational technical school.
- 3 college professors currently using the VTEF – to advise on revisions and assist in the development of the Program of Study grids.
- 1 Chapter 74 licensed academic curriculum coordinator
- 3 academic instructors to work with technical instructors on revision of the frameworks, development of crosswalks between VTEF and Massachusetts curriculum frameworks.
- 1 Industry expert to work with instructors and professors on Culinary Arts VTEF and advise on the appropriate skills and knowledge included in the frameworks.
- 1 labor market expert to work with instructors and professors on Culinary Arts VTEF and advise on the appropriate skills and knowledge included in the frameworks especially those related to strand 2, occupational licenses / national standards.
- 1 technical assistant with experience with supporting teams developing and revising curriculum frameworks.
