Electronics Technician

The Electronics Technician maintains, troubleshoots, and performs repairs on arcade machines, ride electronics, large and small animatronics, dinosaurs and other electronic elements in the park.

- Lubricate and maintain carpenter shop equipment.
- Perform construction laborer work on buildings.
- Unload materials and store efficiently onsite.

Food Service Assistant
