He competed at grappling tournaments and kickboxing fights while in high school and was undefeated. After graduating Devin competed in local promotions, first as an amateur MMA fighter and then turned pro in 2015. Devin always had a strong family bond and included his family in everything he did.

This \$250 scholarship is meant to keep his memory alive and also give back to his school by awarding a student who shared some of the same qualities as he did.

The recipient of this award must be an Old Colony Student, must have played on one of the school's sports teams, and must possess the same strong family values that Devin did. Applicants must submit an essay detailing the extent of their family involvement/values.
