

School Cafeteria Q&A

Can a student pick up meals during remote learning?

Yes, a student or a parent can pick up meals.

Is there a charge for meals?

All students can receive one free lunch and one free breakfast per day. They will have the opportunity while in school to purchase additional items.

Can you change your mind later? Or participate ½ of the time?

Yes, the survey is just to get an idea of who might be interested. There will be two order forms to fill out weekly. For each day on the form, you will be able to choose the meals you would like. Example: If we have, a 2-day form and you only want to order lunches, and not breakfast there will be an option to decline the breakfast options.

What are the options if my child is out on Co-op?

All students will have the opportunity to order meals on days they will not be in the building. If someone is able to pick up the meals, they can follow the remote learning offer.

If I do not qualify for free or reduced meals and my income changes during the school year, can I reapply?

Yes, you may reapply anytime throughout the school year, with any changes in your family or income. Filling out an application may qualify you for other benefits, not just free meals.

Is it ok if my child only gets lunch while in school and does not need to pick up meals during remote learning?

Yes, our school food service will offer meals daily. Your child can pick up meals as needed, it is not required.

Can I order meals for other family members who are at home?

Yes, you can fill out a remote meal order form for anyone under the age of 21.
