Our focus continues to be on the health and safety of everyone associated with Old Colony Cougar Athletics, the state of Massachusetts, and our country. We cannot stress enough that everyone should follow the guidelines from local and national health experts to slow the spread of the virus for as long as it takes. ***I am excited to announce an update on parents attending athletic events.***

### **Outdoor Activities:**

The Athletic Department has prepared a google form to be filled out requiring a registration for up to two parents. This registration is required to be admitted to an athletic contest. When the form is completed your child will be given a spectators pass that you will then present to a game administrator prior to entrance of the Athletic Facility. Admission will **not** be granted to anyone who has not register or is without spectator pass. Spectators are reminded to try to utilize bathrooms prior to being admitted to athletic events. Additionally, the visiting team will be allowed to have 2 parents attend Old Colony Sporting events.

**All in attendance will be required to keep masks on at all times and remain socially distant. Spectator markings will be placed on the spectator side of the fields. Please maintain distance from one another.**

### **Indoor Activities:**

The Athletic Department has prepared a google form to be filled out requiring a registration for up to two parents. This registration is required to be admitted to an athletic contest. When the form is completed your child will be given a spectators pass that you will then present to a game administrator prior to entrance of the Athletic Facility. Admission will **not** be granted to anyone who has not register or is without spectator pass. Additionally, the visiting team will be allowed to have 2 parents attend Old Colony Sporting events. Spectators are reminded to try to utilize bathrooms prior to being admitted to athletic events. **Visiting spectators will not be permitted.**

Junior Varsity Volleyball parents will enter through the main doors of the gym after signing in with the game administrator. Admission will **not** be granted to anyone who has not register or is without spectator pass. Clearly marked spectator seating will be available. Upon the completion of the contest parents will exit through door number 2.

Varsity Volleyball parents will not enter until all junior varsity parents have exited and sanitization is complete. Varsity parents will then enter through the main doors of the gym after signing in with the game administrator. Admission will **not** be granted to anyone who has not register or is without spectator pass. Clearly marked spectator seating will be available. Upon the completion of the contest parents will exit through door number 2.

**All in attendance will be required to keep masks on at all times and remain socially distant. Spectator markings will be placed on the spectator side of the fields. Please maintain distance from one another.**
