I probably won't know what next school year brings until it gets a little closer. Here is just a few things I know will be in place and can direct you of where to look as the beginning of the school year approaches.

Meals will remain free for the entire school year. Every student can get 1 free breakfast and 1 free lunch each day. There will be charges if they want a second meal, double or other ala-carte items. If there is any question in what is included with a meal please ask one of the cafeteria staff. (You can view all ala-carte prices on the website)

Breakfast \$1.50

Lunch \$3.50

We will continue to be a cashless environment during all meal services.

You can deposit money into their account before school starts! Just select the [MySchoolBucks](#) Icon on our [web page](#) to set up an account. If you prefer to send in a check, please make the check payable to Old Colony. On the memo line, put your child's name & ID number. The check will need to be in a sealed envelope with your child's name and ATTN; Cafeteria on the front. Your child will need to bring this to the front office first thing in the morning. I will then deposit money onto accounts before lunch service begins. Please do not forget to write ATTN: Cafeteria☺

To purchase meals is the same for everyone, whether they have money on their account or have free or reduced priced meals. All your child will need is their Student ID at the register for both Breakfast & Lunch. On their ID is a barcode that they will scan at the register. If this is their first year at Old Colony and they do not have an ID yet, we will provide them with a copy of their barcode on or before the first day of school.

Yes, meals are free for everyone but there may be other opportunities/benefits if you qualify for Free or Reduced meals. Please fill out an application if you would like to see if you qualify.

****Free & Reduced Meal Applications will be available on-line around August 9th.** Please check our website for the link at <https://oldcolony.us/about-the-school/cafeteria/> you will have the option to fill it out on-line and submit it to me or print a paper copy and send it in to me at school. All free and reduced applications sent back to school by August 25th will be processed before the first day of school. **PLEASE make sure you are using the 2021-2022 Application.** I will not be able to use prior year's applications. In addition, if you have a student who is attending another school district I will need a separate application. We are the only school in this district and we do not share application information with other schools.
