Each year, Rockland Trust offers a scholarship program to students in our market area. I am thrilled to share that we have enhanced our program for the upcoming year to support students throughout the duration of their post-secondary program.

The Rockland Trust Scholarship will work as follows:

- Rockland Trust will award up to sixteen, \$3,000 scholarships to students who reside within Rockland Trust service areas.
- Scholarships are eligible to be renewed for up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first.
- Scholarships are available to students planning to attend an accredited two or four-year college/university or vocational program, either on a full or part-time basis.
- Students must apply using the Rockland Trust Scholarship application, available on our website at [RocklandTrust.com/Scholarship](https://RocklandTrust.com/Scholarship) beginning February 15<sup>th</sup>. The Scholarship portal will close on Tuesday, March 29, 2022, or once 1,500 applications are fully submitted; whichever occurs first.

We are delighted to offer this scholarship and provide students with the opportunity to fulfill their educational endeavors. Please review the attached program flyer and share this information with the students at your school.

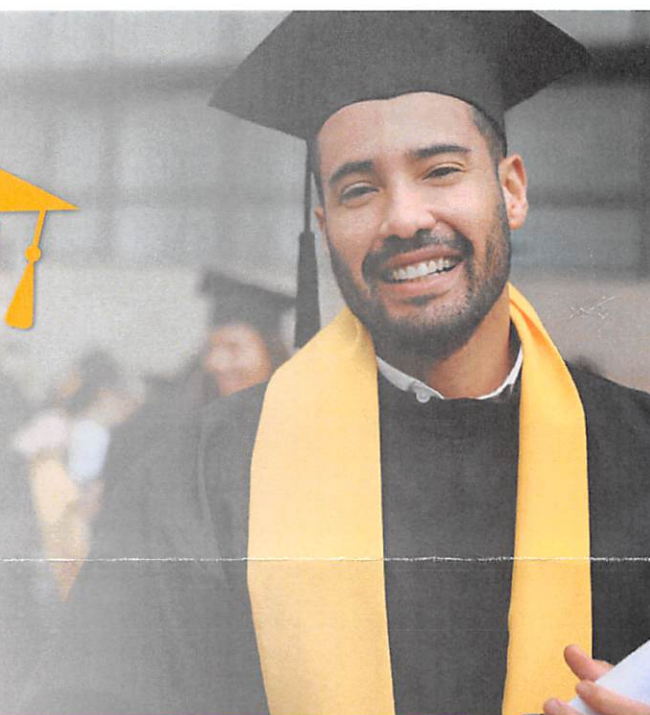

## Apply online for a scholarship today!

Rockland Trust is awarding 16 high school students who are entering college during the fall semester of 2022 with a \$3,000 renewable scholarship.

### To be considered for the program, students must:

- Be a high school senior, graduate, or GED recipient (current college undergraduates are ineligible)
- Plan to enroll in part-time or full-time undergraduate study for the first time<sup>1</sup> at an accredited two or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year (2022-2023)
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent)
- Reside in one of the following Massachusetts and Rhode Island counties: Barnstable, Bristol, Essex, Middlesex, Nantucket, Norfolk, Plymouth, Providence, Suffolk, or, Worcester

**Awards are renewable up to three years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first.**
