



Summer EBT is here!

Summer EBT is a new program that helps low-income families with school-aged children buy food when schools are closed for the summer.

Most students do not need to apply to get Summer EBT.

DTA will pay it automatically to students who get SNAP, certain MassHealth coverage, or other of benefits.

Each eligible student gets \$120 for the summer.

Summer EBT will be put on EBT cards for most students on **July 25**.

Students who need to apply will get Summer EBT based on when they apply.

For families who need to, apply June 15 - September 7 at DTAConnect.com or with a paper application from your school.

If you get SNAP, Summer EBT will go on your DTA EBT card. If you don't get SNAP, DTA will mail out Summer EBT cards in July.
